In January 2016 we started building a massive structure, a gymnasium designed to hold some 400 people for a church of some 70 members. Illogical, undoable, a failure waiting to happen you might say - true, but for God!!! Telling the whole story here is not doable, but God opened door after door and performed miracle after miracle!



And on Feb 22nd, we held the Gran Inauguration of the newly dubbed Father's House - Church & Community Centre. We had over 400 people in attendance!

It was a party! We had food, passionate worship, interventions by Pastors Stewart Hunter, Marvin Sinclair, Margaret Gibb, Marie Miller and others, but best of all was the attendance of some **180 people from Susa itself - more than double the usual Sunday attendance!**

The Father's House is a dream. It is a place where we hope to hold many a worship service, but also play indoor soccer, basketball, hold workshops and invite the community to make it their own. Need a place to hold a meeting? Come to the Father's House. Blood donor clinic, municipal voting? A large wedding? Come to the Father's House!

While construction is ongoing, the participation of multiple outreach teams & donations from across North America have made reality of a simple vision given to our family.

The Gymnasium is finished, the 1st floor meeting rooms are built and the kitchen is in the process of being outfitted - all to serve a community that is already knocking on the door.

At the Refuge Boy's Home we have tried to make a Godly impact and we have seen the results in so many ways.

From the brink of permanent closure, the Refuge that was ranked #17 of the 17 area homes supervised by Colombian Social Services, has now moved up to #9 and is being used as an example for other institutions!

Sometimes you just need a hand up and someone who cares enough to reach out in tough times.



We can talk about the new roof, all of the other renovations that we have done or we can even talk about the boys attending church and being baptised, but one of the most touching things that I have seen with them is a simple mural.

Adorning one bedroom wall, in this semi-tropical country, is the painting of a winter scene from Canada - complete with snowmen, pine trees and frosty cabins. Warm rays of light project from illuminated windows, shining over the boy's beds; who in spite of being left alone by society, feel that dozens of people truly love them from afar and are caring for them in Jesus' name.

And the Teaching?

Well, last month we had a chat with the boys about faith; about how faith is like a seed that needs to be planted and that sometimes we need to take steps of faith so that God will open doors. One of the things that we want to see at the Refuge are two new dormitories. They will increase the home's capacity by about 15 beds and is part of an even bigger project that we will share about later.



So, having nothing but a dream to start with, we held a ground breaking ceremony and taught the boys about faith. We reflected on what God has already done at the Refuge and how we can use that to trust Him for bigger things - for the home and for themselves as they seek to succeed in life.

BTW, we had nothing, but that was then, we will be starting on the foundations next week!
