It was also here that we were able to see some of the after effects of the pandemic. After having so many services curtailed for so long, people were desperate for help.

In just one weekend, we gave out several thousand pieces of clothing and fed some 1300 people each day!



Our doctors and dentists were also in high demand as were dozens of other services we provided. Best of all? The several hundred Bibles given out and the dozens of people who made a declaration of faith. **Please pray for them.**
