Dear Friends,

The end is finally in sight. After four years (5 if you count covid), we are finally coming to the end of **Project Refuge**.

The expansion of the Refuge Boy's Home started with God whispering in our ear about better utilizing the large piece of land that the boy's home sits on, but we weren't entirely sure how best to do so or how to pay for it. 7000 square feet over two floors is not a small thing.



But to quote an old adage, "How do you eat an elephant?"
"One Piece At A Time!"

We started with only a Word from God. We had no money, but we held a ground breaking ceremony, taught the boys a lesson on faith and began to work as funds allowed.



Now, we are in the final stretch. The building itself is complete. The 1st floor is totally finished (ready to receive kids from the community in it's day programs) and now we just lack the finishing work on the second floor.



The 2nd floor is a transition home for university age boys. The guys that come into the Refuge and other state homes, have everything done for them from the time that they are young, but as they age out of the program, many are left without the tools to care for themselves in the real world.



Our transition home solves that problem. Even as they complete their studies, they will also learn how to cook for themselves & other life skills needed to succeed on their own.

This frees up space to bring more, younger boys into the original Refuge and also bring in more youth from other homes that have no transition space. In other words we will more than double the present homes capacity. More boys will hear about and Experience God's Love!

So what's still needs to be done?



Well, as we speak the floors are being levelled. Next steps are tiling, painting, installing the bathrooms, kitchen and all of the furnishings: bunks beds, living room, washer/dryer, stove, fridge, etc. A lot?, **Maybe...**

BUT! compared to having built two stories with no money, raising the last \$35,000 needed to finish this project is...

Recently Pastors Albeiro (al bay ro) and Diana led their church in it's 20th anniversary celebration. The sanctuary was packed for multiple nights as they rejoiced in God's faithfulness, even as they wait for Him to help them continue in their long term goals.

While the church now has it's own home and permanent sanctuary, they were still lacking a functioning Sunday school, offices and guest apartment. While the latter two can be done little by little, [the Sunday School is a high priority](#).



Well, just a few days after their anniversary, we were able to give them a little push and now the 1st steps have been taken to build their Sunday School.

The walls are roughed in and the kids are already using the space. Over the next few months we hope to fully establish this area that will reach kids for decades to come.
